- Familiarity with both manual and CNC machine tool installations are beneficial.
- Provide technical instruction and assistance to clients regarding certifications, at client sites.
- Study blueprints, sketches, drawing, manuals specifications or sample part to determine dimensions and tolerance.
- Use drawings, specs, and/or verbal instructions as well as exercising judgment and experience to plan and accomplish goals.
